

Enumerators for Tree Assessment of National Botanical Garden, Dhaka, Bangladesh

Call for Applications

Bangladesh Forest Department (BFD) with support from USAID's Compass, implemented by the U.S. Forest Service International Programs is planning to conduct the tree assessment in National Botanical Garden (NBG), Dhaka. The overall objective of this assessment is to develop the baseline of total tree stocks, total tree volume, biomass, and carbon of the NBG. To carry out the assessment, the Compass program is hiring almost 15 enumerators for 25-30 Days (February-March 2023).

Key responsibilities

- Participate in the Compass i-Tree training for 3-4 days
- Collect tree parameters from the designated inventory areas
- Entry the collected data into the designated online forms
- Update daily work progress of the respective group
- Ensure security of the group inventory instruments



Basic requirements

- Graduate/final year students in Forestry, Geography, Environmental Science, Botany or, Diploma in Forestry
- Team building and strong interpersonal skills
- Good command of English
